

## Summary to date


- Have compiled residential, commercial/industrial, transportation, waste, and wastewater information for 2013 and 2018
- Need to add agricultural sector working with CCE Tompkins
- Have compiled methane leakage emissions figures

#### Summary to date, cont.



- 2013 total: 109,520 MTCO2e; 2018 total: 98,625 MTCO2e ~10% decrease
- Decreases in eGRID and less HDD in 2018 (residential/commercial/industrial)
- Increase in average vehicle MPG across all vehicle types (transportation)
- Waste: uncertain why increase that wasn't proportionate to increase in population, extrapolated from County data so could be some error
- Wastewater: increase in people using public wastewater in 2018 so decrease in septic use/emissions


#### Residential Emissions



• 2013 total: 25,972 MTCO2e


• 2018 total: 18,910 MTCO2e

### Commercial/Industrial Emissions




- 2013 total: 14,820 MTCO2e
- 2018 total: 12,479 MTCO2e
- Natural gas increase uncertain C/I square footage is estimated so propane/fuel oil use is estimated. Possible increase in C/I square footage or switching from propane to fuel oil that is not accounted for here

### **Transportation Emissions**




- 2013 total: 64,291 MTCO2e
- 2018 total: 62,278 MTCO2e

#### Waste Emissions




- 2013 total: 3,271 MTCO2e
- 2018 total: 3,836 MTCO2e

#### **Wastewater Emissions**



• Septic emissions only — public wastewater treatment facility outside town boundaries

### Methane Leakage Emissions



- 2013: 3.1% increase; 2018: 3.4% increase
- Assuming 2% leakage rate electricity and natural gas
